

Dearborn Homecoming Craft Show

The Craft Show is a major attraction of the annual Dearborn Homecoming celebration at Ford Field in Dearborn off of Cherry Hill and Brady. The three day Homecoming includes Elderfest, high school reunions, multiple food options, a beer tent, Midway, continuous tier one entertainment, Car Cruise & each evening is capped off at dusk with an elaborate fireworks display.

The Craft Show is coordinated by the Dearborn Community Arts Council.

A primary feature of the "Top of the Hill" activities, 28 unique, juried craftsmen will be situated along a curved paved walkway. Demonstrating artisans are given preference when juried.

Calendar: Friday-Sunday, August 7-9

Exhibition times:

Friday: 5-8 p.m.; Sat. & Sun.: 11 a.m.-8 p.m.

Set-up times:

Friday: 2-5 p.m.; Sat. & Sun.: 9-11 a.m.

-Applicants agree to comply with strictly enforced, designated set-up times.

-Only accepted exhibitors may occupy assigned booths.

-Artists sell directly to the public. Each artist is responsible for collection & reporting of 6% Michigan Sales Tax.

-No parking is permitted in the exhibit area.

-Parking is reserved for artists in designated locations only.

Dearborn Police and police cadets provide area security Friday and Saturday nights.

Artisans are expected to comply with all Police & Fire code regulations as required by Michigan State Law.

How to Apply:

Submit four slides or digital images total.

1. Three views should be of the individual pieces to be exhibited at the show.

2. One view must be of the current booth set-up

3. Slides must be standard 35MM or 2" x 2" size.

4. Label each with applicant's name & denote the "top" & "front".

5. Include a description sheet indicating the view number, media, title of work, dimensions & materials used or processes depicted.

Only work of the quality & type illustrated in the slides may be exhibited at the Craft Show.

6. Only submitting artist original work (no imported or mass produced items) are considered.

The non-refundable jury fee is \$15.00.

*If your application is marked "invited" then you have been pre-juried and no jury fee is required.

-The booth fee is \$125.00 for a 10'x10' space with tent provided by DCAC.

Enclose separate checks with the completed application. If rejected, the booth fee will be returned with that letter & your slides/images.

Include a self addressed, stamped envelope (SASE) with your application.

The artist is responsible for any & all returned check (NSF) fees.

Submit by - June 20, 2009 (postmark)

Applications submitted after June 20 must pay \$25 late fee. Late submissions will be considered only if openings are still available in your specific media.

DCAC Notification: Jury Committee selection responses will be mailed by June 30.

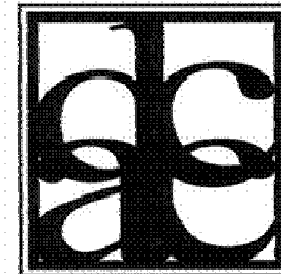
